The CROCHETEA OWNER hands a CUSTOMER tea in a CROCHETED CUP.

SPOKESPERSON: OHH. Crochet-tea. Wow, yeah, your cafe name's

really bad. Kinda proves my point.

SPOKESPERSON walks behind the counter of the cafe as he/she talks to camera.

SPOKESPERSON: As a business owner, you know you need an app,

but you probably don't know where to find a trustworthy person to build one for you. It's okay.

No one's perfect. This guy definitely isn't.

He's talking about the CAFE OWNER, who looks up from pouring tea into a crochet cup, offended. Water leaks out the crochet cup.

SPOKESPERSON: That's where we come in. We're Arren Marketing.

CAFE OWNER: (Interrupts) Yeah, alright Arren Marketing, if that's even

SPOKESPERSON: So starting a new business? That's none of our business.

Spokesperson holds up a phone showing a great looking APP for CROCHETEA CAFE and scrolls through it. The CAFE OWNER looks impressed.

SPOKESPERSON: But making great, high quality apps for businesses is our

business. That way *your* business can be *other people's* business. (to Cafe Owner) Just a thought, put a cup

MOIDE the excelect own weeks

INSIDE the crochet cup, mate.

The Cafe Owner's mind is blown as Spokesperson walks off.

Now SPOKESPERSON speaks to camera from the middle of the cafe, where a few CUSTOMERS (played by same actor) work on laptops:

SPOKESPERSON: At Arren Marketing, we can help you develop a great app AND

effectively market your business, no matter what that business may be.

He grabs a laptop from a CUSTOMER and shows what's on screen: a website for a restaurant called "MANGIA MANGA."

SPOKESPERSON: Whether it's an Italian-Japanese fusion restaurant called

He snatches a tablet from another CUSTOMER, displaying their online newspaper "WARBLER WATCHER'S WEEKLY."
